Requirements and Duties

- Attend 80% of the Student Board of Directors monthly meetings held the first Wednesday of each month at 5:30 PM at the Midland Administrative Building, 615 W. Missouri. Meetings are usually about an hour in length. Eighty percent attendance is necessary throughout the year. Student members in the 8th through 12th grades earn Texas Scholars hours.
- 2. Actively participate in Campus Crime Stoppers fundraisers, if needed. This is to promote the program, raise funds for reward money and operating revenue, and attend the annual state-wide campus crime stoppers training conferences. Parents need to know that support is followed by parental participation. There is nothing we (which includes student members) do to discourage parents from attending meetings or supporting any event.
- 3. Participate in PSA videos and radio announcements, announcements at school, brochure distribution, and poster placement, and also assist Campus Crime Stoppers in its fundraising efforts.
- 4. Maintain a passing grade in all courses.
- 5. Maintain a more than acceptable school attendance record
- 6. Be aware that your school's disciplinary record is available for review at any time.
- 7. Must not have been arrested for any felony or high misdemeanor criminal offenses.
